and rider combination
Horse papers must accompany the entry**

If the following applies to you:

- 1) You would like a chance to win the NRCHA Canadian Region year end awards
Buckle for Champion and Jacket for Reserve**
- 2) You would like to qualify for the World Show in San Angelo, Texas.**
- 3) You would like to participate in NRCHA events**

**If you answered No to all of the above questions, then the NRCHA approval has no impact to you
and you enter the approved ARCHA shows as usual**

**If you do not participate in the NRCHA classes, you do not have to have an NRCHA
membership to enter the approved ARCHA shows.**

If you answered Yes to any of the above questions, keep reading:

You and your horse's owner require an NRCHA number to participate in these events

The NRCHA approved shows will be jackpot show, which means the fees include an office charge to cover approval costs plus a jackpot.

If you wish to enter the NRCHA classes, there are two steps:

- 1) Enter the corresponding ARCHA class for the NRCHA class**
for example if you want to enter Novice Non-pro bridle for NRCHA you have to be entered in the non-pro bridle for ARCHA. You can't enter the novice non pro bridle for NRCHA and the \$2,000 limit for ARCHA.

- 1 NRCHA rules apply
- 2 Owner and Rider must be 2010 NRCHA member
- 3 You must enter the ARCHA class to participate in NRCHA classes - classes run concurrent
- 4 You must follow NRCHA equipment rules for the respective class. For example if you enter the Hackamore class you must show in a hackamore regardless of the provision that allows you to show in a snaffle for ARCHA.
- 5 If you enter class and cancel, you will be charged
- 6 Cheques payable to Cowtown Derby & Stockhorse the day of the show. Do not add NRCHA payment to your ARCHA entry fee
- 7 No cross entry discount for NRCHA classes
- 8 Payout for NRCHA entries based on NRCHA scale and mailed after show
